SIGNIFICANCE

A classic Gilroy pioneer house, important for its minimal alterations. The modifications in architectural elements, brackets to support the overhang and brick work in the chimney indicate this was moved to the present site in the early craftsman era. This little pioneer is not as nice as the house on the former location of the livery, stable on Second Street. It is on the same lot as the stable, however.
