

The front porch is supported by square support columns. The roof of the main portion of the house overlaps the porch roof.

	Originally, both this house and the one to the south (7468 Church Street) were on the same lot and ownership. In 1870, this property was owned by James Crocker, and there was a dwelling on the property. Possibly this is still the described house. Either way, the present house should date back to the previous century, and about the same time as the 7468 Church Street home. Mrs. C. Gould owned the lot in 1901 and J.M. Mullen owned it in 1926.	
	This structure and 7468 represent some of the earlier dwellings on Church Street. Both are significant for the representation of housing style in the 1870's and how that style has been modified as newer structures are built.
