- 7b. Briefly describe the present *physical appearance* of the site or structure and describe any major alterations from its original condition:

This residence is a neoclassic row house with fish scale siding on the front of the second floor peak. Recent remodeling has added shed dormers on both sides of the roof to expand by addition of an additional apartment. It has a front bay window that extends outward by only 8 to 10 inches. The porch used to wrap around the north side of the house to the door of the apartment, but recent remodeling has removed this extended porch and constructed an enclosed garage.

SIGNIFICANCE

19. Briefly state historical and/or architectural importance (include dates, events, and persons associated with the site.)

This unusual house has been re-built and added on to over the years. The first construction on the property occurred in 1875 when it was owned by George Ausan. He built a small frame house and barn. The city fire charts from 1886 to 1906 show a single building similar in size to the present house. The home was renovated in 1979 by Mr. Maurice Ried. He found that it had been built by laying a concrete foundation completely around the original barn and the new structure enclosed the old, the small frame house having been taken down at some point. This odd house, surrounding what was once a barn, is now divided into a triplex. It is owned by Rudy Heredia.
