A craftsman bungalow made of stucco, this smallhouse has a cross gable roofline with exposed rafters and support brackets. The recessed porch has square pillars and brick decoration on the half wall which encloses it. The front windows have small panes surrounding the regular glass and some dentil detailing in the woodwork.

**SIGNIFICANCE**

This house contributes to the streetscape and to the extensive collection of well defined bungalow style residences in Gilroy.

The bungalow style is particularly suited to Gilroy. The overhanging rooflines, use of natural forms, cool materials, and sheltered windows are appropriate to the very warm climate in the South Santa Clara Valley. The importance of the bungalows in Gilroy is the representation of all styles, sized and materials. The total collection reflects the very best as well as more common interpretations, a text book of the bungalow movement.
