This standard craftsman has a medium double gable roofline with rafters exposed at the eaves and clapboard siding. The recessed porch has elephantine columns and is partially enclosed. Decoration on the house includes latticework and stickwork in the gable above the front entrance.

This house contributes to the streetscape and to the extensive collection of well defined bungalow style residences in Gilroy.

The bungalow style is particularly suited to Gilroy. The overhanging rooflines, use of natural forms, cool materials, and sheltered windows are appropriate to the very warm climate in the South Santa Clara Valley. The importance of the bungalows in Gilroy is the representation of all styles, sized and materials. The total collection reflects the very best as well as more common interpretations, a text book of the bungalow movement.
